## Workshop “Value-added products from phyto-industrial organic wastes”

Industrial organic residues from the **phytopharmaceutical** industry are to a large extent composted or deposited as ‘hazardous waste’ although still containing some valuable compounds. Within the EU-funded research project SAFEWASTES several residue materials and by-products of the herbal extraction have been investigated. Some useful compounds were identified showing e.g. antimicrobial and/or antioxidant properties.

The results after two years research will be presented to interested stakeholders in Europe during the **55<sup>th</sup> International Congress and Annual Meeting of the Society for Medicinal Plant Research (GA), Graz/Austria, 2.-6. Sept. 2007 ([www.ga2007.org](http://www.ga2007.org))**.
